Ages (4-5)

Little Vikings: A unique introductory camping experience for four and five year old boys and girls. Each day begins and ends at the YMCA. In between, campers are transported by bus to many different parks and places of interest. Our fantastic staff offers safe and healthy outdoor activities and the caring and understanding necessary for a well adjusted child.



Ages (6-9)

Leif Ericson: In a secure world, a child can run, play, and make new friends. There are horses to ride, campfires to enjoy, and stories to be told. Leif Ericson represents the foundation of the Sioux Falls YMCA camping program. This is a child's world where the spirit moves through the leaves, grasses, and waters of the Big Sioux River. Here the big city becomes an afterthought as campers become connected with the great outdoors.



Ages (10-15)

Tepeetonka: Designed for the older camper, Tepeetonka is a natural extension of the Leif Ericson experience. It recognizes the changing needs for more adventure, more challenge, and more accomplishment. These experiences become all the more meaningful because they are shared with others. This is a distinctive camping experience that has a reputation of instilling traditional values through the example of a superb staff, inspirational campfire programs, and opening reflections each morning at chapel.

Tepeetonka Leadership Camp: This camp was designed especially for fourteen and fifteen year olds. These young adults are too old to be considered campers, but too young to be camp staff members. Tepeetonka Leadership Camp or "TLC" will give these young adults the best of both worlds. A fun and adventurous camping experience, mixed with the challenges of being on staff.

Sitter Service (6-15): Before and after the camp day - for Leif Ericson, Tepeetonka, and TLC campers. Sitter service is provided at the YMCA. Hours are 7:15 am - 5:30 pm. Campers are transported to and from camp. Sitter Service fee is an additional \$60.00 per child.

Did you know?

- One out of every six kids in Sioux Falls goes to Y-Camp.
- Campers are placed in small groups; no larger than twelve to a group.
- Camp is located in Central Sioux Falls.
- Lunch is provided daily for Leif Ericson, Tepeetonka, and TLC campers.

TRANSPORTATION
